Re: Phase II Distance Learning at ASCA

A planning checklist to help parents & students stay organized and up-to-date.

- Be patient with yourself, you are doing the best you can, and we are here to help!
- Building is closed, but classes are **NOT** cancelled!
- Live Zoom (or recorded) *instruction* begins this week. Students can view live, or recorded lessons (if live times do not align with your household for grades N-4).
- Grades 5-8 are required to attend all Zoom sessions for all their classes.
- New Schedule for Special Area Classes – **check their Google Classroom Pages**
 - Monday – Technology w/ Mrs. D’Alessandro (Gd.N-3 will get a planning email from Mrs. D’Alessandro, grades 4-8 will cont. be posted to Google Classroom)
 - Tuesday - Music w/ Mrs. Roorda
 - Wednesday – Art w/ Ms. Morris
 - Thursday – Health w/ Coach Parker (gd. 4-8)
 - Friday – Physical Education w/ Coach Parker
- Grades N-4 - Review your child’s weekly schedule and expectations via Google Classroom and / or the Seesaw platform. Stay in regular contact with teacher, especially if pacing seems too fast for your child. We know every child learns at a different pace. Differentiation is still a very real practice.
- Grades 5-8 have **mandatory class check-ins EVERY DAY!** (ELA, Math, SS, Science, Religion and 1 Special Area Class). Assignments are expected to be “turned-in” to Google Classroom. “Commenting” in Google Classroom is **NOT** counted as submitting assignments. Paper & Pencil assignments are submitted by taking a picture of the assignment(s) (not a selfie of you and the work), and the picture of your assignment is then uploaded into Google Classroom. Clear directions are posted – students in grades 5-8 need to read and follow the Google Classroom/Gmail directions EVERY DAY!

“Just In Case Work” - Please DO NOT open the “just in case” work until directed. Continue to pray we are back in session and won’t need the “just in case work”.
